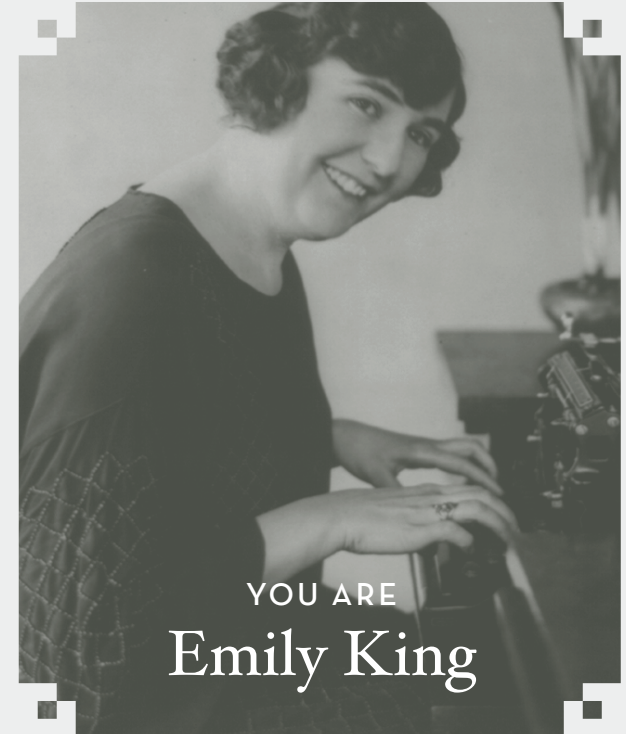

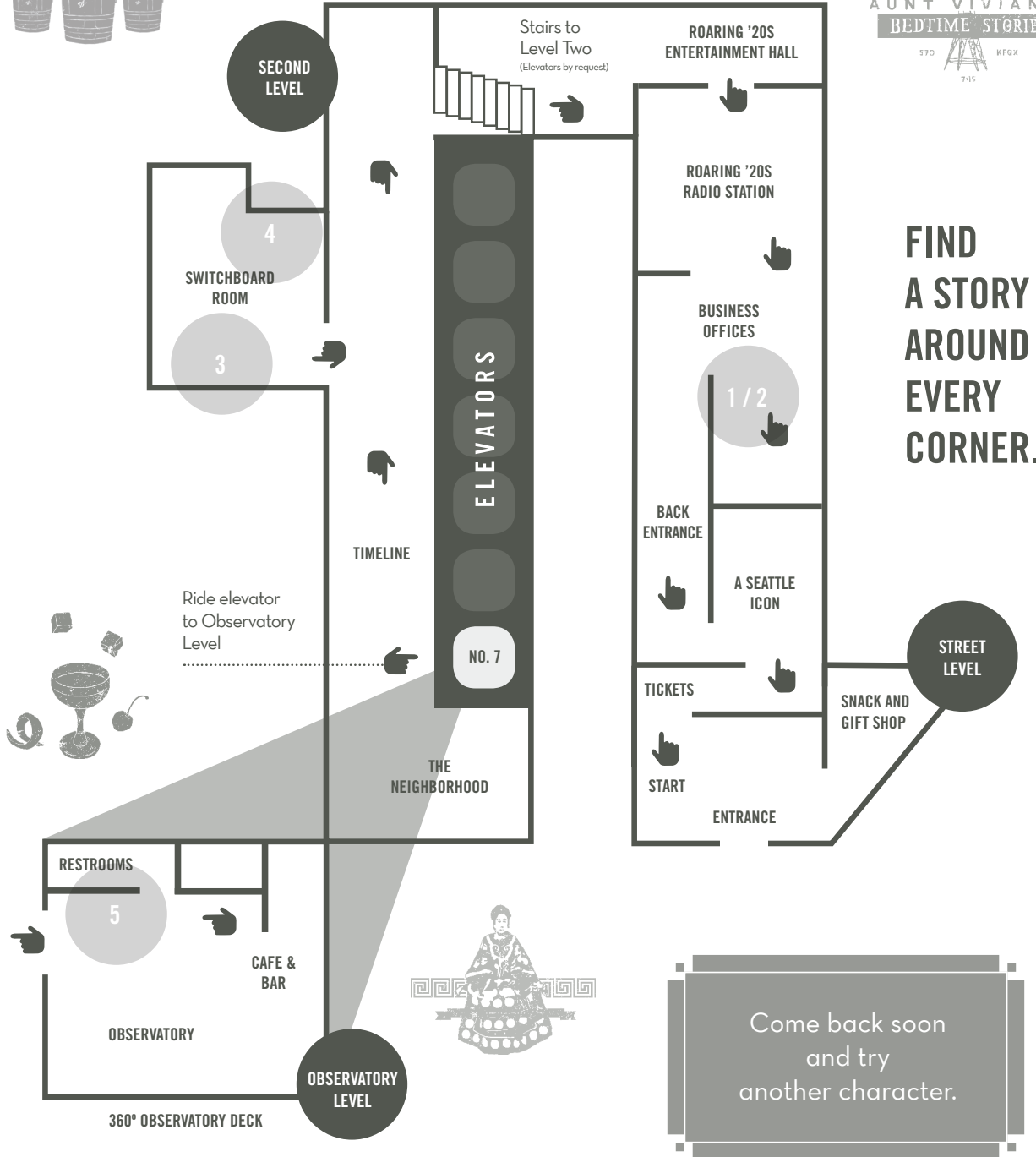


The Ambitious Stenographer
