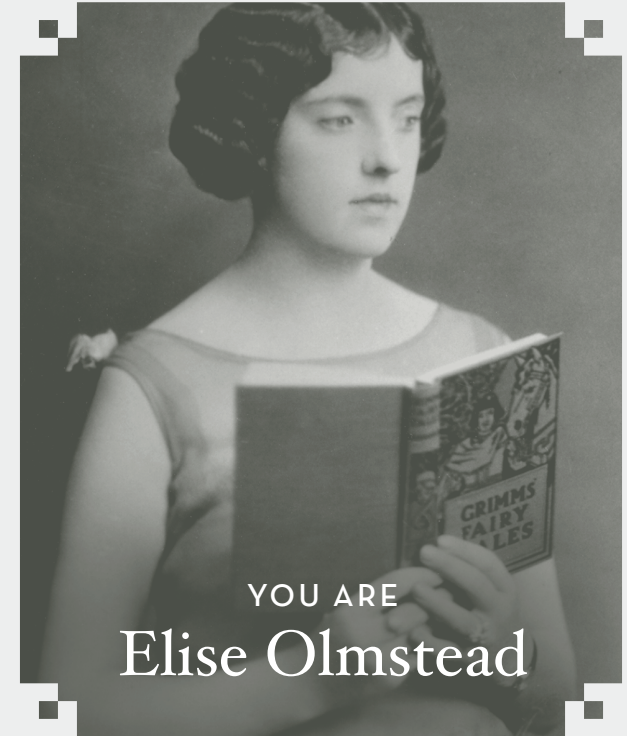

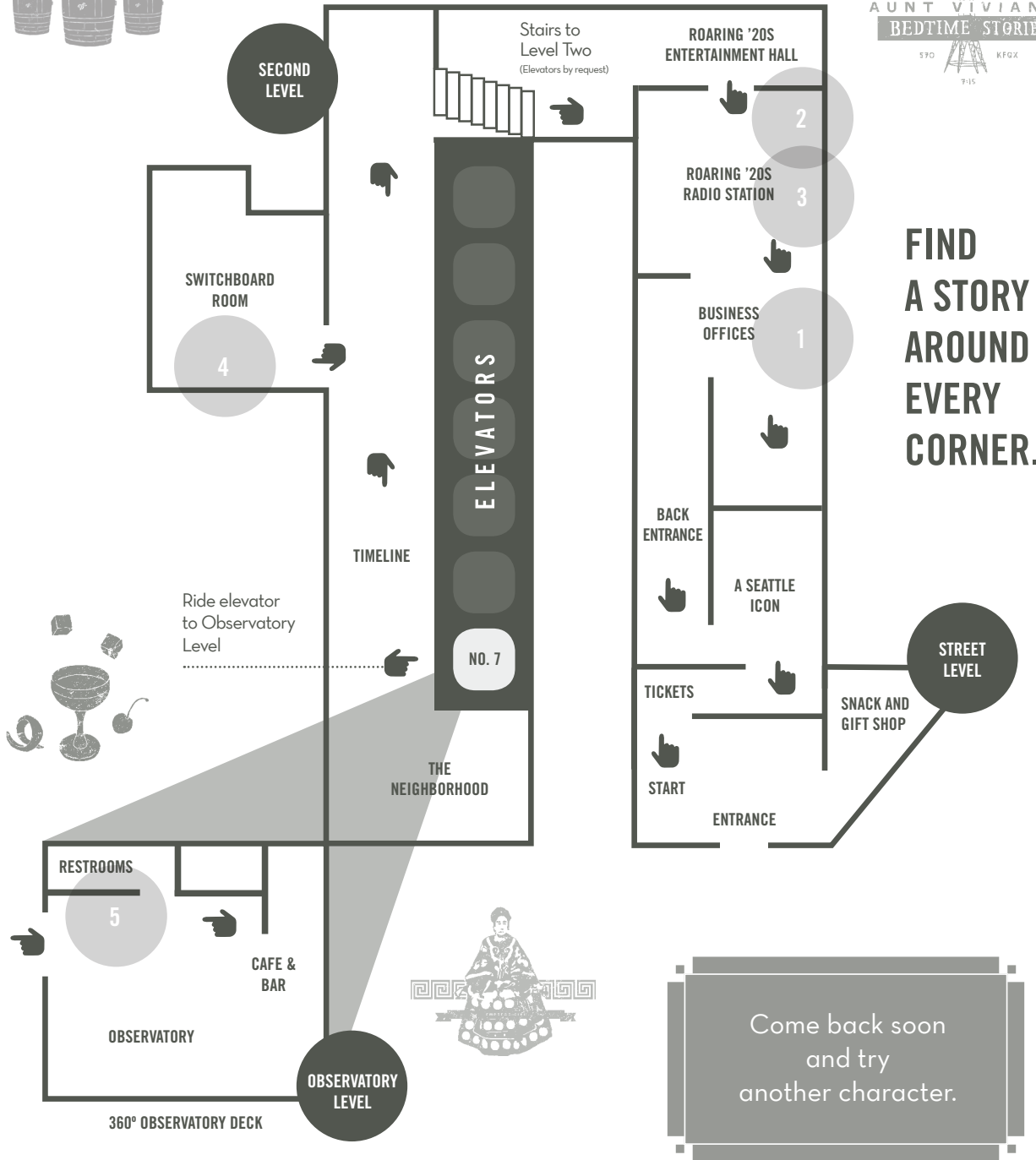


The Rumrunner's Wife and Accomplice
