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### Abeja Winery (Eastside)



Abeja (also pictured at top of page) is both a winery and an inn, known for its scenic grounds that include vineyards on one side and a lily pond on the other. The farmhouse-style tasting room reflects onto the water on a clear day.

Winemakers Dan Wampfler and Amy Alvarez-Wampfler bring deep Washington wine expertise, offering a strong portfolio complemented by a refined dining experience next door at The Kitchen at Abeja, led by James Beard-nominated chef Mike Easton.

New to Abeja are wines from the recently acquired Skyskill vineyard. The Estate Chardonnay and Cabernet Sauvignon are nearing their second vintage, and the merlot—a varietal close to Amy's heart—will be released this winter.
