

Your Ultimate Guide to Where to Eat For Mother's Day 2018 in Seattle

Where to Get Mimosas, Dim Sum, Tapas, Waffles, Fried Chicken, and Everything in Between on May 13

If you procrastinated on making Mother's Day plans, don't worry: we've got you covered with this guide to all the restaurants serving brunches and dinners for the special day. Whether your mom or mother figure is partial to mimosas, dim sum, biscuits and gravy, pork schnitzel, fried chicken, tapas, sushi, or pho, you're sure to find something here guaranteed to cement your status as her favorite. Note: We advise you to make your reservations as soon as possible, as some of these locations may already be fully booked. Call ahead to make sure.

Agrodolce

Maria Hines's Southern trattoria will serve a three-course menu of "brunch classics with an Italian twist," including spring hash, polenta cake Benedict, and focaccia French toast bites.

Andaluca

The romantic Mediterranean spot promises a Dungeness crab Benedict, Eggs Sardou ("a soft-poached egg nestled into a prized artichoke heart with spinach, truffle oil and hollandaise"), and strawberry rhubarb mimosas.

Baron's Bellevue

For an unexpected Mother's Day brunch, try dim sum. Baron's will have shrimp dumplings, mushroom buns, scallop shao mai, lotus leaf sticky rice with duck egg, pan-fried Beijing dumplings, and other "Dynasty-inspired Chinese favorites" served a la carte.

Browne Family Vineyards

At this "Moms, Mimosas, and Macarons" event, pair meringue cookies with sparkling drinks inside the Walla Walla vineyard's Seattle tasting room.

Cafe Flora

The brightly lit vegetarian haven will serve a characteristically fresh, seasonal, three-course brunch menu with fresh-baked pastries (including croissants and lemon blueberry cornmeal scones) and a fruit plate, followed by a choice of Northwest lox benedict, spring chile rellenos, and strawberry-rhubarb-stuffed French toast. Cap off the meal with rhubarb upside-down cake or a dark chocolate raspberry tart.

Chandler's Crabhouse

The seafood spot overlooking Lake Union will serve various variations of eggs Benedict and dishes showcasing fresh seafood like king salmon, Dungeness crab, and bay shrimp.

Copperleaf Restaurant

Go all out at Cedarbrook Lodge's Copperleaf Restaurant, with a chocolate fountain, snow crab and Alaskan prawns, and made-to-order omelets.

District One Saigon

The new Redmond restaurant from the owner of Pho Cyclo will serve a modern Vietnamese smorgasbord of pho, grilled pork with vermicelli noodles, rice rolls with pork and mushrooms, tamarind shrimp, and waffles with coconut cream.

Dunbar Room

Wow your mom with the sleek midcentury decor of the Hotel Sorrento's Dunbar Room and a nourishing menu including an omelet bar, Belgian waffles, fresh fruit, charcuterie and cheese, and freshly baked pastries.

Feed Co

The neighborhood burger joint will dish out a brunch with \$17 bottomless mimosas; biscuits and gravy; bodega-style bacon, egg, and cheese breakfast sandwiches; and more.

Goldfinch Tavern

At Ethan Stowell's elegant Four Seasons Hotel eatery, guests can enjoy an appetizer buffet of starters like maple bacon skewers, salmon lox wrap, ahi poke salad, and artisan cheese, then move on to entrees like mushroom ravioli and strawberry rhubarb French toast. If you have any room left, choose a confection from the dessert bar. For **dinner**, Chef Joe Ritchie will create a fresh, springy, three-course supper with crispy pork belly, spring pea soup, roasted half chicken, morel mushroom ravioli with fried nettles and goat cheese, and raspberry lemon chiffon cake.

Heartwood Provisions

For Mother's Day, the upscale spot known for its modern American food and craft cocktails will serve its new brunch menu, with creative offerings like French toast with kumquat marmalade, ginger congee, and smoked pork shoulder hash. For moms-to-be, there's also mocktails, like a watermelon basil cooler.

Hitchcock, Hitchcock Deli, and Bruciato

Take a ferry ride to Bainbridge to partake in chef Brendan McGill's impeccably sourced spring menu at his restaurant **Hitchcock**, which includes "Mom's bennies" (eggs benedict with king salmon and brioche), stinging nettle and garlic soup, rhubarb mimosas, lemon tartlets, and more. Next door, his charcuterie-focused **Hitchcock Deli** will host a "low-key brunch" with pastries, quiche, green salads, and a special asparagus dish with champagne vinaigrette, poached egg, pine nuts, and shaved grand Padano cheese. To drink, there's sparkling rosé and fresh OJ mimosas. Guests are invited to "pop in on a whim," no reservations necessary. Finally, across the street, McGill's Neapolitan-style pizzeria **Bruciato** will serve a la carte specials like "Mom's Pizza" (a pie with local spinach and chevre, shaved breakfast radishes, wood sorrel, preserved lemons, and fiore sardo) and rhubarb panna cotta. Plus, they'll debut their brand-new Bloody Mary menu with smoky and mezcal-spiked variations on the savory cocktail.

Itto's Tapas

Moms get free dessert at the Moroccan tapas cafe's locations on Capitol Hill and in West Seattle.

Local 360

For a classic, seasonal brunch, try Local 360's menu of locally sourced biscuits and gravy with fried chicken, shrimp and grits, Taylor Shellfish mussels with bacon, and more.

Mamnoon

The chic Middle Eastern establishment on Capitol Hill will serve its regular menu of dishes, like mujadarra, shawarma, and hummus with lamb belly.

Monsoon

Alongside dim sum, the Pacific Northwest/Vietnamese restaurant will showcase specials like crab Benedict, strawberry French toast, housemade rhubarb ginger beer, and Vietnamese coffee Jell-O with coconut ice cream.

Scout PNW

Chef Derek Simcik will prepare an a la carte menu of dishes like Dungeness crab benedict and avocado toast, and executive pastry chef Kate Sigel will assemble a tower of specialty sweets for desserts. Bloody Marys and mimosas will flow forth.

Tacoma Art Museum

Peruse the art of Tacoma Art Museum and dine on a comforting brunch catered by Pacific Grill, with savory fare and sweets like Julia Child's walnut brownie and pear crisp cheesecake bars. Then snap a family portrait as a keepsake. Moms get a complimentary drink.

Water's Table

Heap your plates high with the copious offerings at this buffet, including a carving station with herb-roasted prime rib or pork tenderloin; a hot station with pork belly, roasted salmon, and green papaya cucumber salad; Waldorf salad; charcuterie and cheese; and sweets. Add on \$15 bottomless mimosas for extra points.

Waterways Cruises

Cruise Lake Union and Lake Washington and take in the views as you gorge yourself on buffet fare like brioche French toast and herb-roasted prime rib. Plus, guests will be greeted with a sparkling cider or champagne toast, and the captain will present every mom with a "beautiful rose" upon boarding.

Omega Ouzeri

The sleek Greek eatery on Capitol Hill will serve a lavish spread of "seafood, grilled meats, and lots of veggies."

Ray's Boathouse and Ray's Cafe

The waterfront staple **Ray's Boathouse** will serve a "special holiday menu" for brunch, after which they'll switch to their full dinner menu, with dishes like wild Northwest salmon and pan-seared sea scallops. Upstairs, their sibling **Ray's Cafe** will offer a buffet with salads, appetizers, sweet and savory breakfast foods, and desserts, plus a carving station with house-smoked salmon and a raw bar with oysters on the half shell.

Rhein Haus

Say *danke* to your *mutter* with German brunch offerings like pork schnitzel, wurst on a bun, and a hunter's breakfast with a freshly baked pretzel. Plus, there'll be a family-friendly puppet show in the restaurant's Fire Den recreating classic fables and stories.

RN74

Chef Thomas Griese will present a *très* French buffet with made-to-order omelets, sweet and savory crepes, roasted leg of lamb, and roast chicken. For drinks, options include bottomless bubbles, the RN74 Bloody Mary, or Caribbean Cold Brew with rum and whipped cream.

Salish Lodge and Spa

Treat your mom to a view of Snoqualmie Falls and a menu that includes a a pastry basket with Salish's signature honey, plus cakes, petit fours, and other small sweets for dessert. Options include Dungeness crab bisque, bananas Foster French toast, and pan-seared halibut.

Serafina

The elegant Eastlake standby presents a three-course prix-fixe brunch with options like brioche French toast with Marasca cherries, seasonal pastries, roasted porchetta, and more, with add-ons such as customized bouquets and signature drinks.

Six Seven

Treat your mom to an upscale brunch in the Edgewater Hotel restaurant's dining room, with fresh local seafood on ice, freshly baked pastries, charcuterie and cheese, French toast, herbed gnocchi, king salmon, and a carving and omelette station.

Stone House Cafe

Load up on a classic buffet of staples like eggs Benedict, breakfast potatoes, mini waffles, pastries, and desserts.

Super Six

The Columbia City spot from the owners of Marination will serve bottomless mimosas and its signature Hawaiian-Asian fusion take on American comfort food.

Sushi Kappo Tamura

The acclaimed sushi restaurant will serve a special "gozen" for Mother's Day.

Tango

The casually elegant tapas restaurant and lounge will serve albondigas, bacon-wrapped dates, and other pinchos.

Terra Plata

For extra points, take your mom out to James Beard Award-winning chef Tamara Murphy's brunch. Their famous rooftop will be open, weather allowing.

Tilth

At James Beard Award-winning chef Maria Hines' cozy bungalow in Wallingford, she and chef Joel Panlilio will serve a special three-course prix-fixe menu of their signature organic, farm-to-table fare, including quiche florentine; olive oil-poached albacore tuna, eggs Benedict; sourdough french toast; and a housemade waffle with rhubarb compote, candied pecans, and whipped cream.

Toulouse Petit

The Cajun-Creole kitchen in Queen Anne will serve its normal menu, with dishes like its pork cheeks confit hash and biscuits with spicy sausage gravy.

Tulio

Chef Walter Pisano will craft a special brunch menu. At 5 pm, Tulio will serve their usual dinner menu with Italian fare like pappardelle with rabbit ragu and duck with rhubarb panzanella.

Union Saloon

The cozy neighborhood corner bar will feature a la carte dishes like pork cheek sandwiches, fried chicken, and Bloody Mary slushies.

Urbane

The downtown restaurant will serve a special plated brunch with a yogurt parfait, specialty benedict, fresh baked pastries, and a choice of a blood orange mimosa or bellini. Plus, they'll bestow moms with a flower to take home.

Volunteer Park Cafe

Gather around Volunteer Park Cafe's communal table for a seasonal meal of chilled sweet pea bisque, green goddess salad, a seafood stew, and lemon chèvre cheesecake with berry compote.

Wild Ginger

The Asian fusion stalwart will serve a brunch with favorites from their menu and a dim sum buffet.
